Rationale (see instructions):

1. ART 376 as a required media history course for Print Media is consistent with every Visual Arts concentration which each has its own required media history course.

2. ART 465 Intermedia Studio is a topics course. ART 355 is a new course that is a specific Intermedia Studio topic. So students will be able to take either for the Intermedia course.

3. ART 423 is taken out of the required list, but can still be chosen as an upper-level art history elective.

4. With ART 376 as the Print Media's required media history course, the choice of various media history courses is no longer required. Students may now choose any upper-level art history course that relates to their interests, research, and artistic work.
