## Rationale (see instructions):

The College of Arts, Humanities, and Social Sciences proposes a new minor in Arts and Entrepreneurship, designed to bring together majors from the four arts disciplines (Music, Theatre, Visual Arts, Dance) to explore the intersection of arts and entrepreneurship as an interdisciplinary study. While UMBC currently offers a Minor in Entrepreneurship, offering a minor specialized in the arts will enable our students to fully engage with the special circumstances surrounding young artists launching their careers, and will provide them with the skills and introductory experiences needed as preparation. The minor in Arts and Entrepreneurship will provide a strong complement to our rigorous programs that train students in artistic creation by preparing them even more fully for their creative working lives.

This 18-credit minor is modeled after the UMBC Minor in Entrepreneurship administrated by the Alex T. Brown Center for Entrepreneurship. The Brown Center supports this idea for an additional Minor with more focus on the arts fields. Majors/minors in any of the four arts disciplines at UMBC be eligible. Students are encouraged to begin this minor in their sophomore year.
