A course in which advanced creative writing students work on collaborative or individual projects that embrace more than one artistic discipline or writing genre. ## **RATIONALE FOR CHANGE:**

The current description is very narrow, and would apply to a small number of interdisciplinary projects, whereas the revised description still involves multi-genre and multidisciplinary projects but allows more students to propose these and for a wider variety of projects. The recommended preparation is changed to reflect the change in the course description—it emphasizes coursework in multiple writing genres rather than strictly in multiple disciplines.
