RATIONALE FOR CHANGE:

As the catalog description indicates, this one-credit, P/F course is in fact an independent study course, with no regular meeting pattern. When the catalog record was first created, “Lecture” was probably assigned by default. We would like to correct this by changing the component to “Independent Study” (which has a later deadline for enrollment than “Lecture” courses).
