Rationale:

- a) What are the major departures from the current structure and why is the new structure preferable? This change removes one upper-level Art History course from the visual arts core requirements. It removes 2 courses: ART 314 and ART 375 from 'choose from the following' to required courses. It removes the Approved Upper Level Art Elective (6 credits) ART362 is excluded from the BA, but will be proposed as a required course in the BFA (as a future change).
- b) What provisions will be made to accommodate current students if courses are discontinued? No courses will be discontinued.
- c) If there is a change in required credits, please provide a specific justification for that change.

As the Visual Arts Department begins the application process for the National Association of Schools of Art and Design (NASAD) accreditation, we are seeking to create a greater distinction between the BA and the BFA degrees we offer. This proposed change to the Print Media BA credit count meets the NASAD accreditation standards, while also creating a shorter, more cohesive path to graduation for students entering professional positions requiring more fundamental Print Media skills and principles.
