## Rationale (see instructions):

a) What are the major departures from the current structure and why is the new structure preferable?

The re-location of DANC 350 Dance Workshop from core category to the elective category provides more choice for minors. It alleviates pressure on the schedules of dance minors because DANC 350 requires a co-requisite of a dance technique course, often a challenge. Minors desiring to take DANC 350 will still be able to do so, provided they can meet the co-requisite requirement. The department also proposes to add **DANC 315 Beyond Technique**, an existing course, to the list of electives for the minor. This course provides dance students with a deeper awareness of the movement of the body in dance, and introduces them to methodologies for warm-up, increasing, strength, flexibility, and injury prevention. This is valuable information for dance majors, and for minors who intend to pursue health-related fields, or are simply interested in deepening their physical awareness and knowledge.

## **DANC 315 Beyond Technique: The Body and Motion**

Course Description: This course focuses on techniques that enable dancers to move with physical awareness, efficiency, and enhanced expressivity. Study of the musculoskeletal system will provide students with knowledge of sound skeletal alignment and principles or movement. The course will introduce students to a variety of alternative modalities and approaches to achieving personal movement goals and to move fully and successfully in traditional dance classes of any style. Students will learn techniques for moving with increased range of motion, energy, joint ease, and less muscular tension. Students will explore the use of breath and methods for increasing flexibility and strength
