CURRENT CATALOG DESCRIPTION:

This class affords students instruction in sacred music, predominantly from the African-American heritage. The course will provide an introduction to and study of a variety of musical styles, including spirituals, hymns and anthems. Vocal technique is also part of the class structure. Some vocal instruction will be given, and it is recommended that students take MUSC 170 - Beginning Voice Class and MUSC 171 - Intermediate Voice Class, along with the course. This course is repeatable for credit.
