Rationale (see instructions):

With Music Department's proposal to reduce ensemble credits from 2 to 1, the total required credits for the music minor will drop from a minimum of 18 credits to 15 credits. In order to maintain the 18 credits requirement for a minor at UMBC, we propose to add a 0-3 credits elective requirement to the music minor. Students with less than 18 credits after completing all required courses in the four areas (music theory, music history/appreciation, lessons, and ensembles) are required to take additional music courses to reach 18 credits. Students may choose an additional music history/appreciation course, or additional semesters of lessons and/or ensembles as their electives.

We also propose to include the three upper-level music courses (MUSC 328/333/336) with general education attributes as part of the music minor. This will provide students with more electives to choose from for their music minor.
