The Global Studies Program is submitting a new course proposal for a 400-level elective offering, GLBL 460: Global Stories. This course was designed by Dr. Tania Lizarazo, Assistant Professor in the department of Modern Languages, Linguistics, and Intercultural Communication and a member of the Global Studies faculty team. It will be a key offering in our program, situated in between two required courses (GLBL 300: Methodology) and GLBL 400 (Theory).
