RATIONALE FOR CHANGE:

Students in the Music Technology major and students in the Music Composition major are required to take MUSC 492 Senior Project in their final year. However, since the course is currently unrepeatable, students pursuing double degrees in Music Technology and Music Composition are not allowed to complete TWO MUSC 492, one for music composition (492-01) and one for music technology (492-02). Therefore, the Music Department would like to change MUSC 492 to be repeatable for credits, up to two attempts (4 credits).
