Rationale (see instructions):

Content in BIOL 395 – U-RISE Writing in the Sciences (titled MARC U*STAR Writing in the Sciences until Spring 2021) does not meet minimal biology-related material needed to be a minor elective. BIOL 395 is a 2-credit writing seminar designed specifically for U-RISE scholars. As part of their NIH grant, U-RISE students must take a writing course. BIOL 395 assists students in reading scientific literature, writing CVs, and preparing graduate school/grant applications.

Three years ago, the Department noticed several electives, such as variable credit research courses and one-credit seminars for our special population students (i.e. U-RISE scholars), that were missing from the exceptions list for

the BIOL minor's "Any BIOL 3XX- or 4XX-level course" elective requirement. BIOL 395 was mistakenly left off				
of the UGC proposal to fix this omission.
